





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Roseller Lim, Zamboanga Sibugay

19 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 09 September 2020 at around 2:00AM, a clash between the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and alleged members of the Abusayaf Group ensued in Sitio Limuno, Brgy. Pres. Roxas, Roseller T. Lim, Zamboanga Sibugay that also affected nearby barangays.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **329 families** or **1,560 persons** were affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Roseller Lim, Zamboanga Sibugay** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **261 families** or **1,259 persons** displaced in **Roseller Lim**, **Zamboanga Sibugay** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **68 families** or **301 persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **329 families** or **1,560 persons** displaced in **Roseller Lim**, **Zamboanga Sibugay** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were partially damaged in Roseller Lim, Zamboanga Sibugay (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱966,497.00 worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
