

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ)

10 April 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 17 May 2021 at 4PM, the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affected Mindanao. Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms, and possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms may have been experienced over Regions IX and XII.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **4,023 families** or **20,115 persons** were affected in **32 barangays** in **Regions IX and XII** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **232 families** or **1,160 persons** sought temporary shelter in **seven (7) evacuation centers** in **Region XII** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **183 families** or **915 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **301 families** or **1,505 persons** were displaced in **Region XII** (see Annex D).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,788,564.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱1,718,984.00** from **DSWD** and **₱69,580.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
