

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of LPA embedded along ITCZ

10 April 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 September 2021 the Low-Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 280 km West of Subic, Zambales embedded in the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting MIMAROPA, Western Visayas, Mindanao and Quezon.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **6,119 families** or **25,679 persons** were affected in **Regions VI and XI** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **53 families** or **222 persons** sought temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Regions VI and XI** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **798 families** or **1,936 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **851 families** or **2,158 persons** were displaced in **Regions VI and XI** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **seven (7) houses** were damaged; of which, **four (4)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Cauayan, Negros Occidental** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱137,515.28** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱119,515.28** from **DSWD** and **₱18,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
