

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of LPA as of 05 May 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 03 May 2022, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) located East Southeast of General Santos City (5.2°N, 127.6°E) brought moderate to heavy rains that caused flashfloods in some parts of Region XII and Caraga.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

There are **720 families** or **3,145 persons** affected in **nine (9) barangays** in **Regions XII and Caraga** (see Table 1).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **359 families** or **1,686 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Region XII and Caraga** (see Table 2).

### 1. Standby Funds

- ₱13.68 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱10 million available at DSWD FOS XII and Caraga.
- ₱67.23 million in other DSWD FOS which may support the relief needs of the displaced families due to the effects of LPA through inter-FO augmentation.

### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 25,022 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 24,310 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 712 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Response Center (VDRC), Cebu City.
- 187,539 FFPs available at DSWD FOS XII and Caraga.
- 256,903 FFPs in other DSWD FOS which may support the relief needs of the displaced families due to Effects of LPA through inter-FO augmentation.
- ₱713.21 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD FO warehouses.
