#### 1. Standby Funds

- ₱671 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD-Central Office.
- ₱1.17 million available at DSWD FOs NCR.

#### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 54,339 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 53,510 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 829 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Response Center (VDRC), Cebu City.
- 1,215 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱219.19 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD-FO NCR warehouses.
