I. Situation Overview

On 17 May 2022 at around 7:30 PM, a fire incident transpired at Sitio Sto. Niño, Brgy. NBBS Proper, Navotas City. The fire was declared under control at 9 PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱8.50 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD-Central Office.
- ₱1.17 million available at DSWD FOs NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 46,039 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 45,210 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 829 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Response Center (VDRC), Cebu City.
- 1,215 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱246.90 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD-FO NCR warehouses.
