

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. NBBS Proper, Navotas City as of 19 May 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 May 2022 at around 7:30 PM, a fire incident transpired at Sitio Sto. Niño, Brgy. NBBS Proper, Navotas City. The fire was declared under control at 9 PM.
