



# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flashflood Incident in Pikit, North Cotabato

as of 18 May 2022, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 16 May 2022, several barangays in Pikit North, Cotabato experienced flooding due to the continuous flow of the Pulangi 4 in Maramag, Bukidnon caused by heavy rains.

A total of 1,590 families or 7,950 persons are affected in three (3) barangays in Pikit, North Cotabato (see Table 1).

## 1. Standby Funds

- ₱8.5 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD-Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FOs XII.

#### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 38,039 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 37,210 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 829 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Response Center (VDRC), Cebu City.
- 44,820 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱247.17 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD-FO XII warehouses.
