

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flashflood Incident in Pikit, North Cotabato

I. Situation Overview

On 16 May 2022, several barangays in Pikit North, Cotabato experienced flooding due to the continuous flow of the Pulangi 4 in Maramag, Bukidnon caused by heavy rains.
