

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Armed Conflict in Sto. Niño, Cagayan

19 May 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 April 2022, an armed conflict between the operating troops of the 17th Infantry Battalion (17th ID) and the Communist Terrorist Group (CTG) transpired in the municipality of Sto. Niño, Cagayan. The following day, 15 April 2022, the military conducted close air support in the mountainous area of Brgy. Niug Norte, Sto. Niño, Cagayan which resulted in the evacuation of families.

A total of **269 families** or **920 persons** were affected by the armed conflict in **two (2) barangays** in **Sto. Niño, Cagayan** (see Table 1).

A total of **84 families** or **380 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Sto. Niño, Cagayan** (see Table 2).

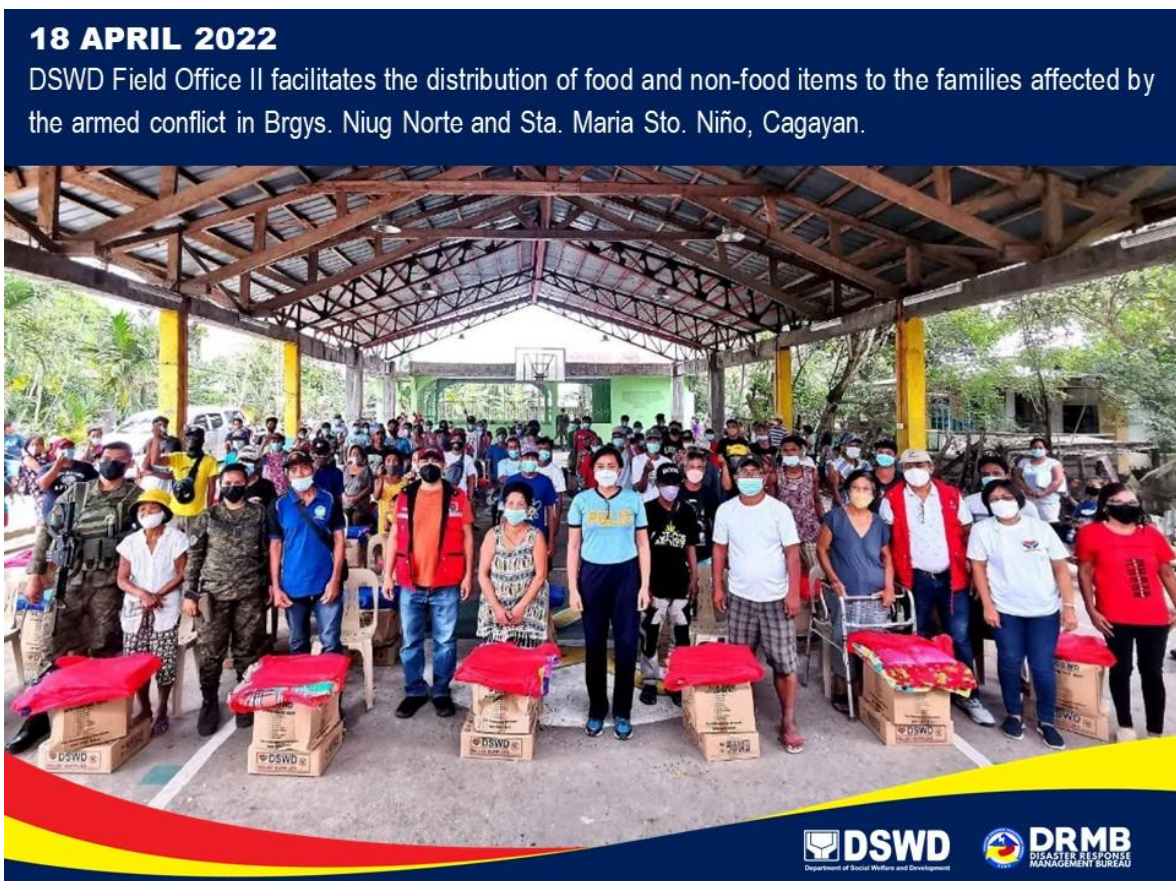
