

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire incident in Brgy. 20, Manila City as of 09 June 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 08 June 2022 at around 2:18 AM, a fire incident transpired at Brgy. 20, Parola, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at 3:59 AM. The cause of fire was due to an unattended candle.
