I. Situation Overview

On 30 May 2022 at around 3 PM, a fire incident transpired at the MRR Track, Brgy.Barangka Ibaba, Mandaluyong City. The incident was declared fire out at 4:58 PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱671 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD-Central Office.
- ₱1.17 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 87,654 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 80,925 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 6,729 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Response Center (VDRC), Cebu City.
- 1,772 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱208.86 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD-FO X warehouses.
