



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flashflood Incident in Sultan Kudarat and South Cotabato

as of 01 June 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 May 2022, the municipalities of Lutayan and Lambayong in Sultan Kudarat and the municipality of Tantangan in South Cotabato experienced flooding caused by the Through of Low Pressure Area (LPA) affecting the southern sections of Mindanao.

A total of 1,192 families or 5,960 persons are affected in ten (10) barangays in Region XII (see Table 1).

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 87,654 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 80,925 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 6,729 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Response Center (VDRC), Cebu City.
- 25,663 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱243.21 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD-FO XII warehouses.
