

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 23-C, Davao City as of 28 June 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 June 2022 at around 3 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 2 and 4, Brgy. 23-C, Davao City. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) XI declared the fire out at 7:08 AM of the same day.
