I. Situation Overview

On 24 June 2022, a whirlwind incident occurred in Pototan, Iloilo.

A total of **15 families** or **77 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Pototan, Iloilo** (see Table 1).

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **five (5) families** or **18 persons** took temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** (see Table 2). All of these families have returned home.
