

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City as of 26 July 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 16 June 2022 at around 10:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City. The fire was declared out at 12NN of the same day.
