



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Paringao, Bauang, La Union

as of 14 July 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 July 2022, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Paringao, Bauang, La Union. According to Bauang Police Station, the fire allegedly started at around 7PM and was declared fire out at 10:25 PM. Most of the houses were made from light materials which caused the immediate spread of the fire.


b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)
