

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Quiot, Cebu City

as of 08 July 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 07 July 2022 at around 11:08 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Sto. Niño, Brgy. Quiot in Cebu City. The fire was placed under control at 12:04 PM at was declared fire out at 12:22 PM.

A total of **95 families** or **358 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Quiot, Cebu City** (see Table 1).

- 150,493 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 98,764 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 51,729 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 8,675 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱170.04 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD FO VII warehouses.
