I. Situation Overview

On 12 July 2022 at 8:18 AM, a fire incident occurred in P-2 Barangay 11, Catbalogan City. The incident was declared fire out at 9:35 AM.

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 145,492 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 93,763 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 51,729 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 20,589 FFPs available at DSWD FO VIII.
- ₱195.08 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD FO VIII warehouses.

13 July 2022	 Continuous validation in coordination with the LGU is being conducted to the affected families and for the damaged houses in the area. A total of 14 affected families with totally damaged houses were provided with ₱10,000 cash assistance each through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS). Further, ₱5,000 cash assistance was provided to each affected family with partially damaged houses.
