as of 28 July 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 May 2022 at around 10:44AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Ka Insong, Brgy. Basak, Lapu-Lapu City. Another fire incident in the same city transpired at Sitio Acacia, Brgy. Pajo at around 5:04PM. The cause of the said two (2) fire incidents is still under investigation.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- ₱192.14 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD FO VII warehouses.


b. Food and Non-food Items

DATE	ACTIVITIES
26 July 2022	 DSWD FO VII distributed cash assistance to the affected families amounting to a total of ₱110,000.00. The Lapu-Lapu City Government distributed food and non-food items to the affected families and persons which includes non-food items such as kitchen wares, mats, towel, mosquito net, hygiene kits and food items comprising five kilograms of rice, 15 canned goods, a dozen of milk and coffee. The affected families and persons were also
	provided with food meals good for three days.
