

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flashflood Incident in Banaue, Ifugao as of 08 July 2022, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 07 July 2022, a flashflood incident occurred in several barangays (Poblacion, Tam-an, Bocos, Poitan, Amganad, Viewpoint) of Banaue, Ifugao caused by recent heavy rains.

A total of **500 families** or **1,500 persons** are affected **in six (6) Barangays in Banaue, Ifugao** (see Table 1).
