

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flashflood Incident in Tangcal, Lanao del Norte

### I. Situation Overview

On 03 July 2022 at 2:12 AM, heavy rains resulted to a flashflood incident in Brgy. Lindongan, Tangcal, Lanao del Norte.
