

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flahflood Incident in Tantaran, South Cotabato

as of 24 July 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 22 July 2022 at around 3AM, a flashflood incident occurred due to the Easterlies and Localized thunderstorms affecting the eastern sections of Luzon and Visayas and the rest of the country.

There are **298 families** or **1,490 persons** affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Tantaran, South Cotabato** (see Table 1).

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **96 families** or **480 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Tantaran, South Cotabato** (see Table 2).
