

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Ivisan, Capiz

as of 13 July 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 10 July 2022 at 4 PM, several barangays in Ivisan, Capiz experienced flooding due to heavy rains caused by the prevailing weather conditions affecting the country.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **500 families** or **1,513 persons** are affected in **six (6) barangays** in **Ivisan, Capiz** (see Table 1).
