

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Malita, Davao Occidental

as of 27 July 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 18 July 2022, a flooding incident occurred in the municipality of Malita, Davao Occidental due to heavy rains.
