

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Mati City, Davao Oriental

as of 15 July 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 July 2022 at 5 PM, a flooding incident occurred in Brgy. Matiao and Brgy. Central, Mati City in Davao Oriental. The affected families have immediately evacuated to their respective Brgy. Gymnasiums.

A total of **31 families** or **137 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Matiao** and **Brgy. Central, Mati City, Davao Oriental** (see Table 1).
