

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incidents due to Over-Spilling of Water caused by the damaged Dampalit Flood Gate in Malabon City as of 10 July 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 June 2022, flooding incidents occurred in Malabon City due to over-spilling of river water caused by the damaged Dampalit Flood Gate that caused flooding in six (6) Barangays in the said city. Though the flooding has already subsided, the properties and livelihood of the families living in the flooded areas have been affected.
