I. Situation Overview

On 09 July 2022 at around 7 AM, a landslide incident occurred in Brgy. Gabon, Abucay, Bataan that resulted in the casualty of one person.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 150,493 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 98,764 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 51,729 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 19,775 FFPs available at DSWD FO III.
- ₱186.55 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO III warehouses.
