



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Camp Evangelista, Brgy. Patag, Cagayan de Oro City

as of 13 July 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 July 2022 at past midnight, a fire incident occurred at Camp Evangelista, Brgy. Patag, Cagayan de Oro City. The incident triggered an explosion in one (1) of the buildings of the Ammunition Complex inside Camp Evangelista. The fire was placed under control at 3:10 AM and was declared fire out at 12:30 PM of the same date.
