I. Situation Overview

On 12 July 2022 at 8:18 AM, a fire incident occurred in P-2 Barangay 11, Catbalogan City. The incident was declared fire out at 9:35 AM.

13 July 2022	 A total of 14 affected families with totally damaged houses were provided with ₱10,000 cash assistance each through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS). Further, ₱5,000 cash assistance was provided to each affected family with partially damaged houses.
