

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in P-2 Brgy. 11, Catbalogan City as of 14 July 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 12 July 2022 at 8:18 AM, a fire incident occurred in P-2 Barangay 11, Catbalogan City. The incident was declared fire out at 9:35 AM.
