

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flooding Incident in Leganes, Iloilo as of 22 July 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 July 2022 at 11:34 AM, several barangays in Leganes, Iloilo experienced flooding due to high tide caused by the surge of seawater reaching the portions of the residential areas.
