

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flooding Incident in Malita, Davao Occidental

as of 01 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On the night of November 29, 2023, Malita, Davao Occidental faced intense rainfall, resulting in flooding across various barangays in Poblacion. In swift response to the emergency, the Municipality Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) immediately deployed emergency responders to conduct search and rescue operations in the affected areas.

According to the weather bulletin released by local PAGASA on the same date, Mindanao is expected to encounter intermittent heavy rainfall, accompanied by lightning, strong winds, and thunderstorms due to the influence of the Easterlies.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **380 families** or **1,366 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Malita, Davao Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **177 families** or **660 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Malita, Davao Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **32 houses** were damaged; composed of **14 totally damaged** and **18 partially damaged** (see Annex C).
