

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flooding Incident in Sto. Tomas, Davao Del Norte as of 27 July 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 July 2022 at around 5PM, a flooding incident occurred due to localized thunderstorms in six barangays in the Municipality of Sto. Tomas, Davao Del Norte

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

There are **1,895 families** or **6,107 persons** affected in **eight (8) barangays** in **Sto. Tomas, Davao Del Norte** (see Table 1).
