

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Quiot, Cebu City

as of 14 July 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 July 2022 at around 11:08 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Sto. Niño, Brgy. Quiot, Cebu City. The fire was placed under control at 12:04 PM and was declared fire out at 12:22 PM.

A total of **101 families** or **372 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Quiot, Cebu City** (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

08 July 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Cebu City Government immediately attended to the needs of the fire victims while conducting a profiling of affected families and individuals. Cebu City through the DSWD also ensured the provision of hot meals that will last for three (3) days.

14 July 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DSWD FO VII continuously coordinates with the Cebu City Government for significant updates and any request of augmentation support.
10 July 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Financial assistance would provide through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) to the affected families. • The Cebu City Government in coordination with the barangay officials would distribute disaster kits and other relief items to the affected families. Housing materials would also be provided pending the finalization of the list of affected families.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO VII for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
