



DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Flashflood Incident in Alabel, Sarangani Province

as of 19 July 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 July 2022, localized thunderstorms brought heavy rainfall in Alabel, Sarangani Province that caused flashfloods in the area.

A total of **221 families** or **1,105 persons** are affected in **five (5) barangays** in **Alabel**, **Sarangani Province** (see Table 1).

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **nine** (9) **families** or **45 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two** (2) **evacuation centers** in **Alabel, Sarangani Province** (see Table 2).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱334.05 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 134,703 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 82,974 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 51,729 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 40,932 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱188.91 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.





b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

15 July 2022	 DSWD FO XII provided 126 family food packs, 63 sleeping kits, 100 modular tents, 51 plastic mats and 51 pieces of malong to the affected families.

c. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
19 July 2022	 The Provincial Government Office of Sarangani provided 50 bags of 25 kilograms of rice to each affected family amounting to a total of ₱50,000.00.
15 July 2022	 The Local Government Unit (LGU) of Alabel provided medicine kit, hygiene kit, plastic mats and served hot meals to the affected families. The Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (MDRRMO) of Alabel conducted Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) to assess the extent of damages. The MSWDO of Alabel continues to monitor and conducts validation on the status of the affected families.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO XII for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
