

## DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Quiot, Cebu City

as of 20 July 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 07 July 2022 at around 11:08 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Sto. Niño, Brgy. Quiot, Cebu City. The fire was placed under control at 12:04 PM and was declared fire out at 12:22 PM.
