I. Situation Overview

On 07 July 2022 at around 11:08 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Sto. Niño, Brgy. Quiot, Cebu City. The fire was placed under control at 12:04 PM and was declared fire out at 12:22 PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱334.04 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 134,703 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 82,974 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 51,729 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 15,157 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱197.51 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.





b. Food and Non-food Items

19 July 2022	 DSWD-FO VII provided 192 family food packs, 96 hygiene kits and 96 sleeping kits to the affected families.
08 July 2022	The Cebu City Government immediately attended to the needs of the fire victims while conducting a profiling of affected families and individuals. Cebu City through the DSWS also ensured the provision of hot meals that will last for three (3) days.

c. Other Activities

19 July 2022	 DSWD FO VII provided a total of ₱920,000.00 cash assistance through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) to the affected families. DSWD FO VII continuously coordinates with the Cebu City Government for significant updates and for further request of augmentation support.
