



DSWD DROMIC Report #8 on the Effects of Southwest Monsoon in the Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR)

as of 16 July 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 July 2022, the Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) experienced cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to the prevailing Southwest Monsoon that caused flashfloods and landslides during severe thunderstorms resulting in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,100 families** or **4,605 persons** are affected in **10 barangays** in **CAR** (see Table 1).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **13 families** or **23 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Poblacion Multipurpose Building** in **Poblacion**, **Banaue**, **Ifugao** (see Table 2). All of these families have returned home.

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱2,709,101.08 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱1,493,395.08 was provided by the DSWD, ₱215,706.00 from the Local Government Units (LGUs) and ₱1,000,000.00 from the NGOs (see Table 6).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱334.04 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱453 available at DSWD FO CAR.
- ₱70.78 million in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs through inter-FO augmentation.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 135,492 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 83,763 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 51,729 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 26,327 FFPs available at DSWD FO CAR.
- 381.929 FFPs in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs through inter-FO augmentation.
- ₱705.62 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO warehouses.





b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

14 July 2022	 DSWD FO CAR distributed FNFIs to the affected families in Hungduan in coordination with MSWDO, DPWH, SWAD Ifugao and LGUs.
11 July 2022	 DSWD FO CAR distributed FNFIs to the affected families in Banaue, Ifugao.
09 July 2022	 DSWD FO CAR unloaded 1,300 FFPs at Lagawe satellite warehouse in Ifugao.
08 July 2022	 DSWD FO CAR delivered 1,000 FFPs as prepositioned goods at PAT Ifugao. DSWD FO CAR assisted the PLGU Ifugao in the hauling of 1,000 FFPs bound to Banaue, Ifugao.

c. Other Activities

13 July 2022	 DSWD FO CAR through its Crisis Intervention Unit (CIU) conducted payout to 1,044 affected families with partially damaged houses amounting to a total of ₱5,220,000.00.
09 July 2022	 DSWD FO CAR Psychosocial Support Program (PSP) Team was alerted to be on standby for possible deployment to Ifugao. DSWD FO CAR coordinated with the Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD) for possible shelter assistance to families with damaged houses.
08 July 2022	 DSWD FO CAR discussed updates and actions taken to Sec. Erwin T. Tulfo in a virtual meeting. DSWD FO CAR coordinated with DSWD FO II for possible augmentation support from Nueva Vizcaya to Ifugao. The Regional Quick Response Team (QRT) of DSWD FO CAR was alerted to be on standby for possible deployment. The Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) and PAT Ifugao QRTs were activated to continuously monitor the incident and ensure the availability of FFPs. DSWD FO CAR coordinated with the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) and Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) for the possible delivery of FFPs to Mountain Province satellite warehouse as need arises.

This report is a continuation of the "DSWD DROMIC Report on the Flashflood Incident in Banaue, Ifugao". The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO CAR for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.

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
