



DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Ligaya, Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro

08 September 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 July 2022, an armed conflict transpired between the 76th Infantry Brigade of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and a group of CPP-NPA Terrorists (CNTs) at Sitio Tiabong, Brgy. Ligaya, Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro.

A total of **450 families** or **2,250 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro** (see Table 1).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **16 families** or **80 persons** sought temporary shelter at a **church** in **Sitio Tiabong**, **Brgy. Ligaya**, **Sablayan**, **Occidental Mindoro** (see Table 2).
