

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Pedro, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan

07 September 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 03 July 2022 at 6 PM, a fire incident occurred at Libis Road, Brgy. San Pedro, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan. The fire was placed under control at 6:40 PM and was declared fire out at 7 PM.

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **six (6) families** or **17 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Loreto-Santos Central School** in **Brgy. San Pedro, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Table 2).

CSWDO Puerto Princesa City provided Emergency Shelter Assistance (ESA), ₱20,000.00 each was given to five (5) families with total damaged houses while a total of ₱100,000.00 was given to 11 families.
