



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Collapsed Wall of Water Waste Lagoon in Nasugbu, Batangas

as of 1 August 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 30 July 2022 at around 9AM, the Waste Water Lagoon of ProGreen AgriCorp, Inc. (Andy Player Whisky - an alcohol distillery company) located in Sitio El Paso, Brgy. Lumbangan, Nasugbu, Batangas collapsed. Based on the initial investigation of the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO), a portion of the 100-meter retaining wall collapsed due to the heavy downpour experienced by the municipality the night prior to the incident.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱247.53 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 93,786 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 42,057 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 51,729 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 14,491 FFPs available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.
- ₱172.29 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO CALABARZON warehouses.

b. Other Activities

31 July 2022	 DSWD FO CALABARZON Regional Director Marcelo Nicomedes J. Castillo called an emergency meeting with the Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) and Crisis Intervention Section (CIS) to immediately assess the situation and identify the necessary interventions. The Emergency Operations Center (EOC) of DSWD FO CALABARZON coordinated with the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MDRRMC) of LGU Nasugbu, Batangas regarding the status of the ongoing clearing operations. The members of Batangas Quick Response Team (QRT) were advised to be on standby for deployment and conduct of Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA).





The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO CALABARZON for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
