I. Situation Overview

On 18 August 2022 at around 7:03 PM, a fire incident broke out at 2620 Dimasalang St., Zone 14, Brgy. 113, Pasay City. The fire was declared fire out at 8:16 PM. The cause of fire is still under investigation.

19 August 2022	 DSWD FO NCR is continuously coordinating with Pasay City SWDO relative to the needed augmentation assistance of the families affected by the fire incident in Brgy. 113, Pasay City. As per initial coordination, DSWD FO NCR shall provide food and non-food items to the families. DSWD FO NCR through the Pasay City SWDO is conducting assessment and validation of the affected families through intake interviews and master listing using the Disaster Assistance Family Access Card (DAFAC).

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO NCR for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
