1. Standby Funds

- ₱760.48 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 71,406 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 40,677 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 30,729 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 17,278 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱108.91 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
