



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 201, Pasay City and Brgy. Merville, Parañaque City

as of 27 August 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 26 August 2022 at around 12:40 PM, a fire incident occurred and affected two adjacent barangays namely Brgy. 201, Pasay City and Brgy. Merville, Parañaque City. It was declared fire under control at 1:19 PM. The cause of fire is still under investigation.
