

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Duljo Fatima, Cebu City as of 25 August 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 04 August 2022 at around 4:05 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Duljo Fatima, Cebu City. The fire was placed under control at 4:40 PM and declared out at 4:49 PM.
