I. Situation Overview

On 16 August 2022 at around 2:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Jibao-an, Pavia, Iloilo due to a plugged transistor radio left unattended, according to the Pavia Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) during their investigation. The fire was declared fire out at 3 PM.
