I. Situation Overview

On 27 August 2022 at around 11:30 AM, a fire incident transpired in Purok 7, Brgy. Limaha, Butuan City, Agusan Del Norte. The cause of the fire is due to electrical arcing. The fire was declared fire out at around 2:43 PM.
