

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. New Lower Bicutan, Taguig City as of 05 August 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 04 August 2022, a fire incident occurred in DOTC Compound, Purok 1, Cabasaan Street, Brgy. New Lower Bicutan, Taguig City. The fire was declared under control at 2:49 PM. The cause of fire is still under investigation.
