

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Ortiz, Iloilo City as of 27 August 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 August 2022 at around 2:51 PM, a fire incident occurred at a boarding house in Gomez St., Brgy. Ortiz, Iloilo City. Based on the investigation made by the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), the cause of the fire was due to unattended open flame from a butane gas stove. It was declared fire out at around 2:55 PM.
